Ellen Grossen, Aged 6, Dies in Hospital

Exeter Twp. Child Expires As Operation for Tumor Being Performed

Suffering only a few days from a brain tumor, Ellen Grossen, aged six, Exeter township, passed away at 10 Monday morning in the Chicago Memorial hospital while an operation was being performed to give her relief from the ailment.

The daughter of Robert and Margaret Sarbacker Grossen, she was born in Monroe, Jan. 20, 1941. Mr. and Mrs. Grossen operate the Walter Haddinger farm, a short distance east of old Exeter.
