Richard Grossen, 7, Dies Early Tuesday

Richard "Dickie" Grossen, 7, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Grossen, Exeter township, died Tuesday morning at 12:30 in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where he had been a patient for five weeks. Death was caused by leukemia.

The youngster had been receiving blood transfusions almost daily since entering the hospital.

The boy was born in Monroe July 16, 1947, the son of Robert C. and Margaret Sarbacher Grossen. He was a second grade pupil in the Monticello schools.
