

**Elsie Haemmerlie**  
**Feb. 18, 1882 - January 14, 1968**

**Miss Haemmerlie Taken by Death; Rites Wednesday**

Miss Elsie Haemmerlie, 85, New Glarus Home for the Aged, died at 10 a.m. Sunday, Jan. 14, in St. Clare Hospital. She had been last admitted there as a medical patient on Dec. 3. Old age complications were fatal. She was previously hospitalized in November.

Miss Haemmerlie was born Feb. 18, 1882 in Engi, Canton Glarus, Switzerland, a daughter of Fridoline and Marie Blumer Haemmerlie. She attended schools in Switzerland and came to America in 1910, settling in Dane County area.

She moved to California in 1920 and lived there 40 years, returning to Monroe in 1960 and lived with her brother-in-law and sister, the late Mr. and Mrs. John Haemmerlie, at 2302 18th Ave., until 1962. She then made her home at Hilltop Haven Nursing Home, South Wayne, until going to the New Glarus Home a year and a half ago.

She was a confirmed member of the Swiss Reformed Church in Switzerland.

Surviving are a sister, Mrs. Fred Steinmann, Niederurnen, Switzerland, and a sister-in-law, Mrs. John Hammerly, Monticello. She was preceded in death by her parents; two brothers, Sam and Leonard in Switzerland, three brothers, Hilarius in 1942 and John in 1954, both in Monticello, and Fred Hammerly Sr., Albany, in 1954, and a sister, Mrs. John (Marie) Haemmerlie, Monroe, in 1962.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 17, in the Voegeli Funeral Home in Monticello. Rev. Linus Wierwill of Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus, is to officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
