Mrs. Hancock, Age 70, Succumbs; Rites Set for Thursday

Mrs. Hulda A. Hancock, 70 years of age, Monticello, passed away at 4:55 Tuesday afternoon at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, after a long illness,

She had been ill since April and had been intermittently hospitalized on four occasions and was re-admitted to the hospital Tuesday morning.

She was born in Washington township on the Wittenwyler homestead, March 28, 1894, the daughter of John and Anna Voegeli Wittenwyler. She attended the Simmons rural school and graduated from the Monticello high school. On July 19, 1912, she was united in marriage to James F. Hancock, the ceremony taking place in Monroe. Following their marriage, they always lived in Monticello.

She was a member of the Women's Relief Corps and of the Royal Neighbors of America lodge,

She is survived by three brothers, John, Matt H. and Walter Wittenwyler, Monticello, and by two sisters, Mrs. Ernest Cotherman, Monroe, and Mrs. Bertha Keller, Monticello.

She was preceded in death by her father, March 4, 1941, her mother, Feb. 2, 1946, and her husband, Oct. 28, 1952.
