

Regula Hefty
September 5, 1856 – February 20, 1947
Native of Area Dies In Kansas at Age 91
Rites to be Held Friday for Mrs. Regula Hefty at Valley Falls

Succumbing to old age complications, Mrs. Regula Hefty, about 91 years of age, native of the Monticello area and remembered by many of the older residents of the community, passed away Tuesday morning at Valley Falls, Kansas.

Mrs. Hefty had been, bedfast for the past two years and passed away at the home of a daughter.

A daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jost. Voegeli, pioneer settlers of this community, she was born on the Voegeli homestead farm, about two and one-half miles northwest of Monticello, She was the second oldest member of a family of 15 children, the late Mrs. John Wittenwyler, Sr., who passed away in February, 1946, being the oldest. She was united in marriage to Melchior Hefty, the ceremony taking place on the same day that the late Mr. and Mrs. John Wittenwyler were married — Feb. 14, 1878, Following their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Hefty moved to Valley Falls, where they continued to reside,

Survivors are three sons and one daughter, and three brothers, Albert Voegeli, Monroe, Emil Voegeli, Monticello, and Wm. Voegeli, Sr, New Glarus. Her husband preceded her in death several years ago,

Funeral services will be held at Valley Falls Friday afternoon.
