Richard G. Hefty, age 61, of 4026 Mackinac, Janesville, died Thursday, October 6, 1994 at his home. Richard was born in Oregon, Wisconsin on April 20, 1933, the son of Gustave and Clara (Grossenbacher) Hefty. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1951 and from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1955. Richard married Frances Loeffel on May 25, 1957 at Immanuel Evangelical United Brethren Church in Monroe, Wisconsin. He was formerly employed as a dairy man by A.M.P.I. and Hawthorne Melody Dairy, and more recently was self employed as an insurance agent by the Greater Insurance Agency of Madison, Wisconsin.

A Janesville resident since 1973, Mr. Hefty was a member of the Mt. Zion United Methodist Church. A former member of the Life Underwriters and the Million Dollar Round table, he qualified for numerous conventions and top producer awards in the insurance field. Mr. Hefty was a former trustee for the Evangelical United Brethren Wisconsin Conference and held many positions within the church, mostly while a member of the Lake Mills Church.

He is survived by his wife, Frances of Janesville; two children, a grandson, two sisters, a brother-in-law and a special friend.

In addition to his parents, Richard was preceded in death by two sisters, Hilda Bissig and Dora Hefty; and a brother Alvin Hefty.

Funeral services were held on Sunday, October 9, 1994 at Mt. Zion United Methodist Church with Reverend Lee Meissner officiating. Graveside services and burial at Highland Cemetery in Monticello.
