Dr. Carl S. Heyl Dies at Cleveland

MONTICELLO—(Times Special) —Dr. Carl S. Heyl, 81, a former minister of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church here and in Washington township, died Feb. 22, in Cleveland, O., according to word received here.

Dr. Heyl came here from Freeport in 1901 and served seven years and eight months. He left here in May 1909.

Born Feb. 8, 1871, he entered the ministry in 1898 and was graduated from the Mission House College and Seminary. It was during his Monticello pastorate, in 1906, that he was married to Frieda Kether of Milwaukee. They had seven children.

For 25 years Dr. Heyl was editor of the Kirchen Zeitung, the church paper, and after the merger of the Evangelical and Reformed churches, he was co-editor of the merged papers.

Dr. Heyl returned here for the 50th and 70th anniversaries of the Washington Reformed church, in 1926 and 1946. Last year his son, Gerald, secretary of the YMCA at Sheboygan, was a guest speaker at services here.
