MRS. RUDOLPH S. HOESLY DIES AT MONTICELLO

Mrs. Rudolph S. Hoesly, aged 78 years, passed away last Wednesday evening at her home, at Monticello. A cerebral hemorrhage caused her death.

She had been an invalid since suffering a stroke five years ago.

She was born in Mt. Pleasant township, April 4, 1854, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Anton Stauffacher. On Nov. 12, 1874 she was married to Rudolph S. Hoesly. They lived on a farm a mile and a half southwest of New Glarus for many years and the past 16 years have lived in Monticello.

Surviving her are: her husband, three sons, Anton Hoesly, Weston, Wis. Edward and Wilbert, Monticello, a foster daughter, Mrs. J. J. D. Hefty, Belleville; one brother, Edward and 12 grandchildren. One daughter, Mrs. Alma Freitag, died last August.

She was a member of the Monticello Evangelical church. Services were conducted at the home, on Saturday afternoon with interment in Highland cemetery, at Monticello.
