

Dorothy I. Hoesly
March 21, 1921 - June 22, 1998

Mrs. Dorothy I. Hoesly, age 77, of rural Brooklyn, passed away on Monday, June 22, 1998 at the Evansville Manor, Evansville, Wisconsin, after an extended illness.

The former Dorothy Irene Best was born March 21, 1921 in Dane County, the daughter of Harley J. and Lillian Mae (Fletcher) Best. She was a 1939 graduate of Belleville High School. On December 2, 1943 she was united in marriage to Robert E. Hoesly at Stoughton, Wisconsin. The couple farmed in Brooklyn Township until 1982.
