Fred Hoesly Dies Following Heart Attack

MONTICELLO, Wis. — Fred Hoesly, 74, former director of the Mt. Pleasant Mutual Fire Insurance Co., died Tuesday at a Stoughton hospital. He suffered a heart attack five days ago and had been hospitalized a day and a half.

Mr. Hoesly was a director of the insurance company from 1933 until his resignation in 1946. He was a former supervisor from Brooklyn township and a member of the Jug Prairie school district board.

A lifelong resident on the Hoesly homestead in New Glarus township, he was born Mar. 14, 1875 on the farm there. He married the former Sarah Voegeli in 1905 at Monticello. She died in 1941.

Survivors are three sons, Clarence, Robert E, and Thomas, all of Brooklyn; six grandchildren, three brothers, Jacob, Belleville; Marx, Boyd, and John, Eau Claire, and two sisters, Mrs. Mike Klassy and Mrs. Sam Klassy, both of Belleville.

Funeral services will be held Friday at 2 p. m. at the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church with the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier officiating. Burial will be in Highland cemetery.

The body is at the Voegeli funeral home and will be taken to the church at noon Friday.
