

**Henry Chester Hoesly**  
**Sept. 10, 1896 - July 6, 1982**

Henry Chester (Chet) Hoesly, 85, Madison, died July 6, 1982, at Rest Haven Nursing Home, Verona.

The son of Henry and Marie Eberhardt Hoesly, he was born in Monroe on Sept. 10, 1896. He was a 1914 graduate of Monroe High School and the University of Wisconsin in 1918, where he was an ag major with a degree in dairy science.

He was married on July 5, 1927, to Marion E. Burgy at Monticello. He worked as a salesman of dairy equipment in Madison until he retired in 1962.
