Rites Held Tuesday For Mrs, Stanley R. Holliday, Area Native

Funeral services for Mrs. Stanley R. Holliday, 78 years of age, Madison, who passed away Sunday morning in St. Mary's hospital there after a long illness, were held at 2 p. m. Tuesday in the Bashford Methodist church, Madison.

The Rev. Duane Hulse, pastor, officiated, and burial was in Roselawn Memorial Park, Madison.

The former Emma Krueger was born in Mt. Pleasant township, Oct. 14, 1885, the daughter of William and Augusta Gehler Krueger. She attended the Silver rural school near her home. On Aug. 17, 1915, she was united in marriage to Stanley R. Holliday. They had been residents of Madison for over 30 years.

She was a member of the Bashford Methodist church in Madison and a past president of its Aid society.

Surviving are her husband; a son, Frank, Madison; two brothers, Henry, Monticello, and William, Albany; two sisters, Mrs. Nellie Zweifel, Monticello, and Mrs. Mabel Rhyner, Albany, and two grandchildren.
