Dr. Harry J. Horne, 67, Prominent Local Dentist, Succumbs

The entire community was plunged into sadness Tuesday afternoon when it was learned that Dr. H. J. Horne, 67, passed away at 3:15 p. m. at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, after suffering a heart attack in his dental office here Monday morning.

Dean of professional and business men here, Dr. Horne had practiced dentistry in Monticello since 1910.

Born in Brodhead May 24, 1888, Mr. Horne was a graduate of the Brodhead high school and from the Marquette University dental school, Milwaukee, in 1910.

Dr. Horne was a World War I veteran and a 25-year member of the Amstutz-Marty post, American Legion. Dr. Horne was a member of Monticello Union lodge, and the Wisconsin Dental society.

A true lover of the outdoors, Dr. Horne could be seen enjoying a brisk walk or relaxing in the sun on a bench along Main street at every opportunity that he had. He derived great pleasure from visiting with his many friends and acquaintances and he will be greatly missed by all who knew him.

He is survived by two sisters, Mrs. William Green, Orfordville, and Miss Grace Horne, Brodhead, and one aunt, Mrs. Sarah Loomis, Brodhead. Dr. Horne was preceded in death by his wife, one brother, R. W. Horne, Brodhead, and two sisters, Mrs. Clarence Johnson, Chicago. and Mrs. Orla Brewer, Brodhead.
