Mrs. Bertha B. Keller, 94, former Monticello resident died Tuesday, Feb. 2, 1982 in Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe, where she had resided since Dec. 1973.

She was the former Bertha Barbara Wittenwyler, who was born on Jan. 16, 1888, in Washington Township, Green County. Her parents were John and Anna Voegeli Wittenwyler. She attended school in the Simmons rural school.

On Nov. 11, 1909, she was married to Joseph Zweifel in Monticello. He died Feb. 22, 1917. She later married Otto J. Keller. He died Sept. 5, 1923. She had resided in New Glarus before moving to Monticello, and had been making her home with her daughter, Mrs. Hazel V. Kundert, at Monticello, prior to entering Pleasant View.

Funeral services were held Friday, Feb. 5, in the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge, Monticello. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated and burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Hazel V. Kundert, Monticello, and Mrs. James (Helen) Knoblauch, Cambridge, one grandson and three great-grandchildren.

Preceding her in death were her parents, two sisters, Mrs. Hulda Hancock, Mrs. Rose Cotherman, and three brothers, John, Matt and Walter Wittenwyler.
