

Rudolph Klassy

Aug. 23, 1901 - January 24, 1978

Funeral services were held Friday, Jan. 27 for Rudolph Klassy, 76, New Glarus, who died Tuesday, Jan. 24, following a heart attack.

Mr. Klassy was a farmer most of his life and was born in Exeter Township on Aug. 23, 1901, the son of Fred and Christina Schrepfer Klassy.

Surviving are a sister, Mrs. Emil Christen, New Glarus, and nieces and nephews,

He was a member of the Monroe V.F.W. and the Stuessy-Kuenzi American Legion Post of New Glarus. He was a veteran of World War II, entering service on Aug. 20, 1942, and being discharged on May 20, 1945.
