May 14, 1893 - December 8, 1960
Mrs. Jacob Kopp, Mt. Pleasant, Dies

Mrs. Jacob Kopp, 67, Route 1, Monticello, died at St. Clare hospital last night at 11:30, five hours after being admitted. She had suffered a brain hemorrhage.

She was the former Elise Ingold, daughter of Jacob and Elise Ingold Ingold, born May 14, 1893, in Heimenhausen, Canton Bern. She taught school in Switzerland before her marriage in 1923. The Koppes came to Green County in 1924,

They farmed near Argyle until 1941 and since then in the Monticello area, most the time in their present Mt. Pleasant Township farm. For a time, Mr. Kopp was Monticello police officer.

Mrs. Kopp was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, at Monticello.

Surviving are the husband; three sons, Louis, Route 2, Monticello; Rudolph, Footville, and Frederick, Route 1, Monroe; four daughters, Mrs. Permin (Verena) Graber, Route 2, Monticello; Mrs. Robert C. (Hedwig) Wuethrich, Route 1, Monroe; Mrs. Herbert (Martha) Scherer, Juda, and Mrs. Donald F. (Ruth) Ruf, Orangeville; a sister, Mrs. Traugott Vogt, and a brother, Hans Ingold, both in Switzerland, and 17 grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by a brother, Jake, in Switzerland, and two grandsons, John Scherer in 1956 and Richard Lee Graber in 1957.
