

**William W. Krueger Jr.**  
**Jan. 18, 1896 - August 20, 1967**

ALBANY - William W. Krueger, 71, retired carpenter and resident here since 1939, died yesterday noon of an apparent heart attack in the yard of his home.

Born in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, Jan. 18, 1896, the son of William and Augusta Gehler Krueger, he was married Feb. 15, 1922, to Nettie Anderson. The couple farmed north of Albany until moving here in 1939. He had been employed at Doyon-Rayon Lumber Co. until his retirement and was a member of Albany Norwegian Lutheran Church.

Surviving are a son, Eugene, and a grandson, Dennis, both of Albany; two sisters, Mabel Rhyner, Albany, and, Mrs. John (Nellie) Zwifel, Monticello.

His wife died in 1965.
