Henry Kubly, Age 88, Dies After Extended Illness; Rites Held

Funeral services for Henry Kubly, 88 years of age, retired Mt. Pleasant township farmer, who died last Thursday at 6:30 p.m. at the Masshardt Nursing home, Monroe, were held at 2 Sunday afternoon at the Zwingli United Church of Christ here. The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Grandsons Alvin Goepfert and Richard Kubly, Monroe, Edwin, John, Kenneth and Keith Zeller, Madison, served as pallbearers.

Mr. Kubly had been in failing health for the past several years.

Native of Switzerland

A native of Switzerland, he was born in Matt, Canton Glarus, Dec. 27, 1869, the son of Abraham and Sylvia Schindler Kubly. He received his education in Switzerland and came to the United States as a young man, settling in Green county. On Feb. 7, 1895, he, was united in marriage, in Monticello, to Anna Kubly. They always farmed in the Monticello area and owned and operated a farm northeast of the village from 1901 to 1942. The farm is now operated by their son, Henry.

Mr. and Mrs. Kubly retired to the village in 1942 and after the death of his wife in 1949 he lived with his children and in Monroe.

Mr. Kubly was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Joseph Goepfert, Monroe; one son, A. Henry Kubly, Monticello; 13 grandchildren and 23 great-grandchildren,

He was preceded in death by his wife, two daughters, Mrs. Lillie Veenje and Mrs. Edna Zeller, Madison, one sister, and one brother, Abraham.
