John Kubly, Age 79, Monroe, Succumbs

John Kubly, 79 years of age, a native of Mt. Pleasant township and resident of Monroe for nearly 30 years, died at 1:40 p.m. Saturday in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, 20 minutes after being admitted, having suffered a heart attack in his home.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon in the Stuessy Funeral Home, Monroe. The Rev. Melvin J. Roehrdanz, pastor of the United Methodist church, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery.

He was born in Mt. Pleasant township, Jan. 8, 1892, a son of Abraham and Mary Baebler Kubly. He attended the Silver rural school near his home. On Jan. 21, 1915, he was married to Dora Feldt in Zwingli church, Monticello. They purchased a farm in Decatur township, where they resided until moving to Monroe in July, 1942.

Mr. Kubly was a member of the United Methodist church and a former member of the Swiss Club of Monroe. Mr. and Mrs. Kubly observed their golden wedding anniversary with an open house in 1965.

He is survived by the widow; a son, Burnett, on the home farm on Route 2, Brodhead; three sisters, Mrs. Walter (Lydia) Wittenwyler, Mrs. Matt (Anna) Wittenwyler, Monticello, and Mrs. Marion (Ida) Swann, rural Albany; four grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by four brothers, Abraham, Jr., Henry, Dan and Conrad, and a sister, Mrs. Marie Dooley.
