David Kundert, Age 70, New Glarus, Dies

David Kundert, 70 years of age, New Glarus, father of Mrs. Walter Hammerly, Monticello, died Monday afternoon in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where he had been a surgical patient for about two weeks.

He was born in Exeter township on Jan. 6, 1895, the son of David and Mary Hefty Kundert. He attended schools in New Glarus. On Oct. 6, 1915, he was married in New Glarus to Anna Zimmerman. They farmed in Exeter township until moving to New Glarus in 1920. Mr. Kundert worked as a blacksmith for some time and later was an auto mechanic in New Glarus for many years, retiring in 1962.

Mr. Kundert was a member of the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus.

He is survived by the widow; three sons, Reumond, retired Army officer, now vice president of Military Sales Department of Associated Brands International, Tokyo, Japan, and Sylvan and David, Jr., both of New Glarus; the daughter, Mrs. Hammerly; a brother, Henry D. Kundert, Sauk City; a sister, Mrs. T. P. Pfaff, Sun Prairie; six grandchildren, and one great-grandchild.

The funeral will be held at 2 p. m. today (Thursday) in the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus.
