

## **Emily Legler**

**Sept. 4, 1874 - December 29, 1969**

### **Mrs. Emily Legler, Age 95, Dies; Rites Planned for Friday**

Mrs. Emily Legler, 95 years of age, widow of Andrew W. Legler, and a former Mt. Pleasant township resident for many years, died Monday at 12:55 p.m. at the Brodhead Convalescent Home of old age complications.

Emily Schlittler was born in Washington township on Sept. 4, 1874, a daughter of Jacob and Barbara Schlittler. She attended rural school. On April 13, 1893 she was united in marriage in New Glarus to Andrew W. Legler. The couple farmed in Exeter township until 1903, when they moved to the Ridgeway vicinity, where they farmed for 13 years. They moved from there to Mt. Pleasant township and farmed southeast of Monticello for 30 years. Later they lived with a son, Burnett, on farms near Oregon and Verona until 1954, when they went to make their home with a daughter, Mrs. John C. Schmid, Brodhead.

Mr. Legler died in 1956.

Mrs. Legler broke a hip in 1962 and had been residing at the convalescent home since.

She is survived by one son, Burnett, Verona; one daughter, Mrs. John C. Schmid, Brodhead; three grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by three brothers, one sister, and two grandsons,
