William Lemon, 78, Dies at Residence

William W. Lemon, 78, of 503 20th avenue, died at 4 a. m. yesterday at his home as a result of a heart attack. He was a retired Washington Township farmer.

Mr. Lemon was born in Washington Township Aug. 31, 1874, a son of William and Rebecca Willis Lemon. He attended the Washington Township public schools and was married to Marie Loertscher Feb. 27, 1906.

He moved to Monroe and built a new home in 1949. He was a member of the Immanuel church and a worker in the Sunday school.

Mr. Lemon leaves his wife, Marie, and one brother, Jesse, Monticello. Preceding him in death were his parents, three sisters, Mrs. Jacob (Ethlyn) Blumer, Mrs. Henry (Myrtie) Figi, and one in infancy.
