

**Margaret Lewis**  
**April 15, 1872 - July 19, 1937**

Albany—Mrs. Jay Lewis, 65, died at 10:15 a. m. Monday in her home, following a long period of ill health. She suffered a heart attack last Thursday night.

Born in Exeter, near Dayton, April 15, 1872, she was a resident of this vicinity nearly all her life. Her parents, Mary McCollow and James M. Marshall, came to Dayton from Ireland. She was married Dec. 28, 1892 in Evansville to Jay Lewis, and they occupied farms in this vicinity except for five years until moving to the village in 1919. For two years they lived in Beloit, and for three years in Green Lake.

Survivors are her husband, one daughter, Mrs. Arnold Ayres, Brodhead, a brother, Harmon Marshall, Freeport, Ill. and a sister, Mrs. Charles Jordan, Wheeling, W. Va. A son and a daughter died as infants.

Mrs. Lewis was a member of the Methodist Ladies' Aid and of the Albany Eastern Star.

Funeral services will be held in the home at 2 p. m. Thursday, the Rev. H. A. Erickson of the Baptist church here, officiating. Burial will be in Exeter cemetery.
