

**Armin Fred Loeffel**  
**Sept. 15, 1919 - April 22, 1960**

Funeral rites for Armin F. Loeffel, 40, Monticello, who died Thursday night at his home after a heart attack, will be held Sunday at 2 p.m. in the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.
