Mrs. Silas Loveland Passes in Brodhead Born in Mt. Pleasant Twp. Aug. 25, 1863; Burial Rites Held

Funeral services for Mrs. Silas Loveland, 72 years of age, Brodhead, native of Mt. Pleasant township, who passed away Sunday afternoon in a Madison hospital, following an illness of approximately five months, were conducted yesterday afternoon at 2 in the Everson funeral home, Rev. J. C. Hoffman, officiating. Burial was in the Exeter township cemetery.

Ellen Lewis was born in Mt. Pleasant township Aug. 25, 1863, the daughter of Benjamin and Elizabeth Lewis. On Feb. 23, 1897, she was united in marriage to Silas Loveland, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. The couple lived on a farm in Washington township for three years following their marriage. In 1900 they moved to Corona, S. D., and 20 years later they returned to Green county, taking up their residence in Brodhead, where they had continued to live.

Survivors, besides the widower are two brothers, Silas and Elias Lewis, both of Albany, and 33 nephews and nieces.
