Mrs. Lizzie Lovesee Dies; Funeral Tuesday Forenoon

Mrs. Lizzie Lovesee, 77 years of age, for the past number of years a highly respected resident of Monticello, succumbed to death in her home here Saturday afternoon, following a lingering illness. Her death was caused by nephritis. Asthma was contributory.

Lizzie Thompson was a native of the state of Vermont, having been born there May 7, 1852, the daughter of Mr, and Mrs. James Thompson, When she was only seven years of age, the Thompson family left Vermont and traveled west, taking up their home in Rockton, Ill.

She was united in marriage to Dr. Edwin R. Lovesee at Lake Geneva on Nov. 12, 1873. Mrs. Lovesee was preceded in death by her husband, who was a veteran of the Civil war. His demise occurred here several years ago,

The deceased is survived by one daughter, Mrs. W. E. Bontly, Monticello; one brother, J. W. Thompson, Maple Hill, Kansas; and three grandchildren, Maurice Bontly, Chicago; and Leon and John Bontly, Monticello.

Funeral services, in charge of Rev. Bartel, of the Evangelical church, and Rev. Muehlmeier, of the Reformed church, were held in the home here at 10:30 Tuesday morning. The remains were then taken to Roscoe, Ill., for burial.
