Robert Lynn, Local Native, Dies in West Heart Attack Proves Fatal To Veteran Commercial Photographer

Robert J. Lynn, 55 years of age, a brother of M. E. Lynn, of this village, passed away suddenly at his home in San Diego, Cal., Sunday night following a heart attack, according to news received here Monday.

Native of Monticello

Robert J. Lynn was a native of Monticello, having been born here Oct. 17, 1887, the son of John and Mary Edgar Lynn. He attended the Monticello public schools and graduated from the two-year high school course here. At Madison West high school in Madison, he completed the four-year high school course, following which he entered the University of Wisconsin as a student in pharmacy. In 1910 Mr. Lynn left Monticello, going to Norfolk, Va., where he was employed as a commercial photographer, a vocation which he followed until his death. He was united in marriage in Madison to Miss Stella Meyers, of Michigan. At San Diego Mr. Lynn was employed as a photographer for the Consolidated Aircraft Corporation.

Surviving are the widow and one daughter, Mrs. Shirley Atterberry, Los Angeles, Cal., and one brother, M. E. Lynn, Monticello.

Funeral services were held yesterday (Wednesday) afternoon in Los Angeles and burial was also in that city.
