

Anna Marie Marty
Feb 18, 1871 - April 14, 1949

ALBANY — Funeral services for Mrs. Anna Marty, 78, who died Thursday in a Monroe hospital, will be held today at 2 p.m. at the Albany Methodist church.

The Rev. Harvey Norenberg, pastor of the Belleville and Albany Reformed churches, will officiate. Burial will be in the Monticello (Highland) cemetery.

The body will be taken from the Sharer funeral home at noon today to the church where it will lie in state until the hour of the services,

Mrs. Marty died after a long illness,

She was born Feb 18, 1871 in Schleithem, Switzerland, the daughter of Christian and Elizabeth Stamm Tenger.

In Switzerland, she was married to Jacob Hoesly, who died in 1896. In 1906 she and her two children, Jacob, Jr. and Elizabeth, came to the United States and settled in New Glarus.

In 1908, she married Yost Marty in Monticello. They lived on 2 farm near Albany for many years. Mr. Marty preceded her in death. She moved to the village of Albany two years ago.

Mrs. Marty was a member of the Zwingli Reformed church and its auxiliaries.

Surviving are two sons, Jacob Hoesly, Jr., Albany, and Daniel Marty, Rock City, Ill; three daughters, Mrs. David (Elizabeth) Jones, Brodhead, Mrs. Fred Krouse, and Mrs. Leonard Weiss, both of Monroe; two brothers and a sister, who are living in Switzerland; 14 grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren.
