Carl J. Marty Primrose, Dies

NEW GLARUS — (Special) — Services for Carl Joseph Marty, 66, who died at his farm home north of here yesterday, will be held at 9:30 a. m. Friday at St. Mary's of Lourdes Catholic church in Belleville, with the pastor, Rev. Esdres Gariapy, officiating.

The rosary service will be held tonight at 8 in the Zentner funeral home. Burial will be in St. James cemetery, Dayton.

Born in Canton Schwyz, Switzerland, April 15, 1886, Mr. Marty was the son of Michael and Mary Ruchmut Marty. He came to America in 1905 and worked in this localit for a while as a cheesemaker and moved to Sacramento, Calif. On his return from California in 1916, he joined with his brother in the purchase of the farm, where he had since lived. Mr. Marty was married at Mt. Horeb to Josephine Frieda Marty April 21, 1925. She died July 19, 1944.

Surviving are four children, Mrs. Stanley Starczynski, Mt. Horeb; Mrs. Daryl Babler, Monroe; Rose and Carl Jr., at home; one brother and six sisters in Switzerland, and four grandchildren.

Mr. Marty was preceded in death by three brothers, Joseph, in 1950; Frank in 1947; Benjamin in 1930 and two sisters in Switzerland.
