

Elisa Marty

March 21, 1889 - Aug. 25, 1973

Mrs. John (Elisa) Marty, 84, Monticello, died at 1:25 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 25, in St. Clare Hospital from an apparent heart attack. She had been admitted to the hospital July 31, with a broken leg following a fall at her home.

The former Marie Elisa Krusi, was born March 21, 1889 in Peoria, Ill. When she was 2 years old, she returned with her family to Switzerland, where she was raised. Returning in 1910, she and John Marty were married Jan. 27, 1914, by the late Rev. P. A. Schuh in St. John's United Church of Christ, Monroe.

They farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township until moving to Monticello in 1936. Mr. Marty died Dec. 28, 1960.

Mrs. Marty was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, and its Ladies Aid Society, at Monticello. She was a first cousin of the late Dr. Albert Schweitzer, who visited her in 1954.

Surviving are a brother, Henry, and a sister, Miss Emma Krusi, both of Switzerland, and a nephew, John J. Marty, Monroe.

The funeral service will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday in Zwingli Church with the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier officiating. Burial is to be in Highland Cemetery.
