Mrs. Mathias Marty, Mt. Pleasant, Dies Monday; Rites Held

Funeral services for Mrs. Matthias Marty, 79 years of age, resident of Mt. Pleasant township for nearly 75 years, who passed away at 12:50 Monday morning at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient since June 19, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon at the Zwingli United Church of Christ. Fanny Stauffer was born in Finland on Jan. 4, 1883, the daughter of Niklaus and Marie Hageman Stauffer. When she was a child of five she came to this country with her family, settling in the Monticello area. She attended the Elmer rural school in Mt. Pleasant township. On Nov. 1, 1904, she was united in marriage to Mathias Marty, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. Mr. and Mrs. Marty had always lived in Mt. Pleasant township. Mr. Marty passed away July 27, 1958.

Mrs. Marty was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ and its Ladies' Aid circle.

She is survived by five sons, M. Albert, Edward J. and Wilbert, Monticello, Herman N., Belleville, and Clarence W., Madison; one daughter, Mrs. William J. Reagen, Madison; one brother, Alex Stauffer, Stockton, Calif.; 13 grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, three brothers, Edward, June 9, 1919, Robert N., March 3, 1950, and Emil, Duluth, Minn., and one grandson, Steve Groves.
