

**Miss Marie J. Marty**  
**Oct. 27. 1886 - March 4, 1984**

Marie J. Marty, 97. formerly of Monticello. died at Pleasant View Nursing Home on March 4, 1984, where she had been a resident since Jan. 1981.

Born in the Marty homestead farm in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, on Oct. 27, 1886, she was the daughter of John and Anna Babler Marty, who were early Mt. Pleasant pioneers. She attended the Babler rural school and had lived on the homestead farm until moving to Monroe in 1952.

She was a confirmed member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where funeral services were held on Wednesday, March 7, in the Memorial Lounge. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated and burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Survivors include two brothers, Jacob Marty, Monroe, and Herman Marty, Reno, Nev., and one sister, Mrs. Christ (Anna) Balsiger, Monroe.

Preceding her in death were her father in 1938, her mother in 1950, four brothers, Mathias, 1958, John, 1971, Adam, 1972, and Henry, 1981; and a sister, Barbara, 1887.
