

## **Mary Anna Marty**

**May 9, 1890 – September 1939**

**Mrs. Nic. Marty, 49, New Glarus, Passes**

**Former Washington Twp. Resident Called After Long Sickness**

Funeral services for Mrs. Nic. Marty, 49 years of age, a native of Washington township, who passed away at about 5 o'clock Thursday afternoon in her home, were conducted at 1:30 Sunday afternoon in the home and at 2 in the Swiss Evangelical and Reformed church, New Glarus. Rev. Richard Rettig, church pastor, officiated. Interment was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.

### **Ill Many Years**

Mrs. Marty's untimely death came after an illness which had its inception about seven years ago. Much of the time she was bedfast and she failed gradually until the end which came Thursday after the long term of suffering which she endured.

Mary Anna Baumgartner was a native of Washington township, having been born May 9, 1890, a daughter of Anton and Katherina Rhyner Baumgartner. She was confirmed March 24, 1907, in the Zwingli Reformed church, Monticello, by Rev. Carl Heyl. On March 5, 1908, she was united in marriage to Nic. Marty, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. Following their marriage the couple followed the vocation of farming a short distance west of the village in Washington township. They moved to New Glarus 25 years ago.

News of Mrs. Marty's untimely death occasioned sincere regret among her many friends in the New Glarus and Monticello communities. During the years in which she resided near Monticello she established a large circle of friends and acquaintances, all of whom held her in the highest regard.

Surviving besides the bereaved widower are one daughter, Miss Leona, and one son, Clarence, both at home; and three brothers, Fred Baumgartner, New Glarus, and John and Conrad Baumgartner, Belleville. She was preceded in death by an infant son.
