
Marty, Wilbert A.

MOUNT HOREB - Wilbert A. Marty, age 74, died on Tuesday, May 26, 1998 at his residence.

He was born on December 14, 1923 in Monticello Wisconsin, the son of Albert J. and Fanny (Schultz) Marty. Mr. Marty graduated from Monticello High school in 1941. He served in the United States Army Air Force from 1942 until 1945 as a tail gunner on a B-17 serving in England, and held the Air Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters, and the Distinguished Flying Cross. In 1949 he graduated from Whitewater State Teachers College. Mr Marty taught Social Studies and coached football and Junior Varsity basketball in Columbus, Dodgeville, Sheboygan and Mt Horeb for a total of 37 years. One of his loves was to play golf.



Surviving are his wife Lois Emmert, formerly of Elgin, Illinois to whom he was married on June 14, 1952; and also his four children, Debra (Roland) Witte of Waterford, Wisconsin, Lynn (Ronald) Grames of Florissant, Missouri, Cynthia (Greg Zerkle) Marty of Jackson Heights, New York, and Larry (Sue) Marty of Chanhassen, Minnesota; seven grandchildren; a sister, Irene Marty of Monticello; a brother-in-law, Chuck (Judy) Emmert of Elgin, Illinois; and nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and a brother, Melvin who was killed in World War II.
