Willis J. Marty, Middleton, Dies

A retired Monticello businessman, Willis J. Marty, 63, Middleton, died unexpectedly last night in a Madison hospital after an apparent heart attack.

He had owned - operated the Marty Oil Co. in Monticello until retiring in 1952. At the time of his marriage to Grace Durst he was a salesman for a hardware company in Milwaukee. They were married Nov. 19, 1927 in Milwaukee.

Mr. Marty was a native of Monticello. His wife is the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. M. C. Durst. Her father was a Green County sheriff, undersheriff and deputy for a number of years.

Mr. Marty was a member of St. Luke's Lutheran Church in Middleton and had served as church treasurer eight years. He was a member of the Masonic lodge at Monticello and Zor Shrine, Madison, and a member of the Middleton Men's Golf Association, and treasurer of the Middleton Industrial Development Corp.

Surviving are his widow, Grace; a brother, Lawrence G. Marty, and two sisters, Mrs. F. H. Steinmann and Mrs. J. C. Legler, all three of Monticello.

Funeral services will be at 1:30 p.m. Thursday in St. Luke's Lutheran Church, Middleton. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello. Graveside services will be conducted by the Monticello Masonic lodge at 3 p.m.
