**Herman Milbrandt, 85, Area Native, Dies**

Funeral services for Herman A. Milbrandt, 85 years of age, native of Mt. Pleasant township, who died at 1:45 p. m. Sunday at the Hilltop Haven Rest Home in South Wayne, where he had resided for the past four years, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon in the Stuessy funeral home, Monroe.

The Rev. Melvin J. Roehrdanz, pastor of Immanuel EUB church, of which Mr. Milbrandt was a member, officiated, and interment was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.

Mr. Milbrandt was born in Mt. Pleasant township on Oct. 26, 1879, the son of August and Minnie Lipke Milbrandt. He attended rural school near his home. He was the last of his family.

He was a retired highway employee, both on county and state roads. Mr. Milbrandt, who never married, had lived in Monroe for many years.

Nieces and nephews are the only survivors. He was preceded in death by four brothers, Henry, Monticello, Frank and Will, Evansville, and Charles, Watertown, S. D., and three sisters, Mrs. Julia Miller, Monticello, Mrs. Amelia Mau, Britt, Iowa, and Mrs. Charles Brechlien, Monroe.
