Passes Away After Few Weeks Illness

Funeral rites for Mrs. C. W. Netherwood, aged about 79, Oregon, for many years a resident of Monticello, whose death from heart trouble occurred in her home in that village Saturday morning, were conducted at 1 o'clock Monday afternoon in the Netherwood home and at 1:30 in the Methodist church at Oregon.

The remains were brought to Monticello after the services for interment in the Railroad avenue cemetery next to her first husband, Fred J. Breylinger.

Mrs. Netherwood's death terminated an illness which had its inception about the first of December, Although she was up once just before New Year's when she was apparently recovering. Mrs. Netherwood had been confined to bed during the remainder of the time. Her condition took a decided turn for the worse in the last week and the end came Saturday.
