

J. Talmadge Niffenegger

1891 -1918

The remains of J. Talmadge Niffenegger, mention of whose death was made in these columns last week, were brought to Monticello yesterday and interred in Highland cemetery, following funeral services which were held earlier at the home of his father-in-law, Ed. Cheesebro, living a few miles south of Monticello. The Messenger regrets that it has no data on hand from which to write an obituary, but suffice it to say that he was a young man of sterling worth and the memory of his many manly qualities will not soon be forgotten by those who knew him best.

He graduated from the short course in the College of Agriculture, University of Wisconsin, some years ago, and was employed as manager of a large stock farm near Janesville at the time he was stricken with the dread disease which finally resulted in his death. He was about 26 years of age and is by survived a wife, formerly Miss Zetta Cheesebro, and one child.
