Gustav Norder Dies at 89 in Juda, Ill For Several Years

Gustav Norder, 89, resident of the Juda vicinity for many years, died at 10:30 p.m. Tuesday at his home after several] years illness. Gustav Norder, son of Leonard and Magdalena Stauffacher Norder, was born in New Glarus Feb. 13, 1857. His parents were pioneer. residents of the New Glarus vicinity. After his marriage to Anna Geigel, Oct. 19, 1880, the Norders moved to Sylvester township where they farmed until retiring and moving to Juda 25 years ago.

The Norders celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary several months before Mrs. Norder's death in September, 1945. He was a member of the Juda Evangelical church and the last of a large family.

Surviving are five children, Mrs. Henry Haberman, William and Henry Norder, Juda, Mrs. Fred Coplien, Monroe, and Mrs. Henry Moser, Janesville. There are seven grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.

Last rites will be conducted at 2 pm. Friday in Zion Evangelical church, Juda, with Rev. Peter Retzlaff officiating. Burial will be in Dutch Hollow cemetery.
