

Charlotte Nye
September 30, 1859 - July 26, 1913

Charlotte, wife of John W. Nye and daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Bartlett was born in Attica, Green county, Wisconsin, September 30, 1859 and departed this life July 26, 1913, at the age of 53 years, 9 months and 26 days.

The deceased was united in marriage to John W. Nye July 3, 1886. To this union four children were born, Chauncey, preceded his mother to the better world April 16, 1891 at the age of 3 years, 6 months and 26 days.

She was a noble christian, a kind mother and a faithful wife. She had a kind word for everyone and her many kind acts will long live in the remembrance of those who knew her.

She had been in poor health for nearly three months, and no tongue could tell, no one could realize the pain she suffered. But with all her suffering had faith in Jesus and so many times would ask God to help her and guide her in her awful suffering. The reading of the bible seemed to ease her pain, and many many times she would look up and say, "Oh, if I could only be with Jesus," and "I'd love to be with Jesus." What faith she had in Jesus.

When the time came for her to make her journey across that mystic river she looked up at her husband and said, "John, am I going home tonight?" and "won't that be glorious."

Over the river she has gone, only a little in advance of us and let us hope that in the golden summer of another life we will meet again. We will meet in a sweet reunion, where partings are unknown.
