Mrs. P. Patterson, 48, Former Resident of Monticello, Dies

Funeral services for Mrs. Parker Patterson, 48 years of age, former Monticello resident, who passed away suddenly Friday in her Brooklyn township farm home, were held at 2 Sunday afternoon in the Becker funeral home, Belleville.

The Rev. Robert Boettcher, pastor of Peace Evangelical United Brethren church, Brooklyn, officiated, and burial was in Brooklyn.

Mrs. Patterson died suddenly of a heart attack, shortly after she had prepared the noon meal Friday.

Margaret Mildred Holdrich was born Sept. 30, 1907, on the farm where she passed away. She was the daughter of John and Ida Babler Holdrich. She was united in marriage to Parker Patterson and the couple lived in Brooklyn and Evansville before moving to Monticello.

Mr. Patterson was employed at the W. L. Wichser implement shop upon moving to Monticello. He later entered the trucking business here. In 1941 Mr. and Mrs. Patterson moved to the farm where they since resided.

She is survived by her husband; two sons, Lee, at home, and John, Whitewater; and one daughter, Mrs. Milton Baumgartner, Brooklyn. Mrs. Patterson was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Elwyn.
