Sgt. Marvin Pederson Killed in Viet Action

Sgt. Marvin C. Pederson, age 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. Clifford Pederson, Mt. Pleasant township, died in Vietnam last week from wounds received in action. The Pederson family resides on the Jacob Marty farm, southeast of Monticello.

The parents were advised of Sgt. Pederson's death by military personnel.

Sgt. Pederson entered military service June 19 1967. He received his basic training at Ft. Campbell, Ky. and had been in Vietnam since June 23, 1968

He was a sergeant in the 39th Infantry, 2nd Battalion, 9th Division. He attended schools in Monroe, Argyle and Monticello.

Surviving are the parents, Clifford and Arlene Hendrickson Pederson, and a brother, Steve, a sophomore at the Monticello high school.

Rites Held Friday for Sgt. Marvin Pederson

Funeral services for Sgt. Marvin C. Pederson, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. Clifford Pederson, Route 1, Monticello, who died on Jan, 6 from wounds suffered in action in Vietnam, were held at 1:30 p.m. Friday in Grace Lutheran church, Monroe.

The Rev. Larry Pinnow officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.

Full military rites were conducted at the graveside. The flag-draped casket arrived home last Wednesday.
