

Mary Estelle Peterson
July 11, 1901 - Aug. 23, 1987

Mrs. Mary Estelle Peterson, 86, New Glarus Home, and formerly of Monticello and Chicago, died Sunday, Aug. 23, 1987, at the Home.

She was born in Monticello July 11, 1901, the daughter of Edwin and Siddle (Brayton) Wallom. She graduated from Monticello High School in 1918 and later attended Appleton Business College in Wisconsin. She married Algot W. Peterson in June 1925 in Chicago.

She spent her married life in Chicago and after the death of her husband in February 1967, came to Monticello in 1969. She resided there until entering the New Glarus Home in January 1983.

Survivors are one daughter, Mrs. Wally (Darlene) Walters, Monticello, Fla.; eight grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her mother in 1954, her father in 1955, and a brother, Claude, March 21, 1984.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ and the Ladies Aide Society, the Home Missionary Society, Daughters of American Revolution and was past president of the John Ross Women's Relief Corps No. 83 when it was active in Monticello.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Thursday at Zwingli United Church of Christ with the Rev. Erwin H. Pegel officiating. Interment will be in St. Lucas Cemetery, Chicago.

Visitation will be held after 7 p.m. Wednesday in Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge and between 9 a.m. and the time of service Thursday in the church sanctuary.
