1858 – January 1936
Mrs. Pierce, 77, Dies

MONTICELLO — Funeral services for Mrs. James E. Pierce 77, who died of pneumonia and complications early Tuesday, will be held at 2 p. m. Thursday at the Pierce home.

Born in Washington township, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Fridolin Blum, she spent the greater share of her life in Green county.

She was married to Mathias Kundert at Milwaukee in 1875. They resided there until 1891, when they returned to Monticello.

In 1903, she was married to James E. Pierce.

Survivors are the widower, a daughter, Mrs. F. J. Zweifel, Milwaukee; five grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, six step-children; and seven brothers and sisters, Mrs. Anna Juingt, Fred Blum, E. J. Blum, Monticello; Mrs. Lena Wild, Belleville; Kate Fischli, Milwaukee; Sam Blum Monroe, and John A. Blum, Hampton, Iowa.
