### **Preston Prisk, Area Native, Succumbs**

Preston Prisk, 67 years of age, Monroe, a native of Mt. Pleasant township, died at 2:20 a. m. Tuesday at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, after a long illness. He had suffered from arthritis since 1934,

He was born Nov. 14, 1893, the son of William and Elizabeth Evans Prisk. He attended the Silver rural school. On Feb. 25, 1929, he was united in marriage to Pauline Rabe, the ceremony taking place in Freeport, Ill. Mr. and Mrs. Prisk farmed northeast of Belleville until ill health forced him to leave the farm. They had made their home in Monroe since 1942.

He is survived by his wife; one son, Alan C. Prisk, Green Bay; four brothers, Ora, Monticello, Mark, Belleville, Jackson, River Falls, and William, in California; one sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Voegeli, Monticello, and two grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Verne, in 1945, and by two sisters, Mrs. Lottie Retzell, 1930, and Mrs. Gertrude Stauffacher, in 1956.
