## JAMES B. PURCELL CALLED BY DEATH

## Assessor in Washington Township 37 Years Succumbs app. 1857 – Oct. 19, 1924

James B. Purcell, aged 67, for 37 years assessor of Washington township, passed away at 8 o'clock last night at his home, following an illness of several months. Mr. Purcell first became ill last March and submitted to an operation in Madison, June 17, for stomach trouble. He returned home after seven weeks.
