

Edward H. Quade
Feb. 10, 1923 – Aug. 14, 1976

Edward H. Quade, 53, Monticello, longtime employee of the Wisconsin Power and Light Co., died on Saturday night Aug. 14, 1976 at 10:05 p.m. in the University Hospitals, Madison, after a brief illness.

Born in Janesville on Feb. 10, 1923, he was the son of Emil and Mae Veitch Quade. He graduated from Mineral Point High School in 1941.

Mr. Quade entered military service on Feb. 8, 1943, at Milwaukee. He served with the U.S. Army and at the time of his discharge was Tech/4. He served almost two years with the 448th Military Police Unit in Iceland. He was discharged on Dec. 30, 1945, at Camp McCoy.

After his discharge he began employment with the Wisconsin Power and Light Co., with which he has remained for 31 years. He had been a Monticello resident since 1949, except for a period in 1958-59 when he and his family lived in Verona. He was a local Monticello representative for the Wisconsin Power and Light Co. for many years. For the last few years he had been working in the engineering department in Monroe.

Mr. Quade was married on July 21, 1951, at Sextonville, Wis., to the former Lois Marie Schuerman.

Surviving are his wife, Lois; a daughter, Jan, a student at UW-Platteville; and four sons. David, UW-Madison student, and Jon, Bradley and Bruce, all at home.

He was preceded in death by his father in 1961, his mother in 1963, and a brother in infancy.

He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and a member of the church council.

Mr. Quade was also a member of the Amstutz-Marty Post 256 of the American Legion and honorary member of the Monticello Fire Department.

Services will be Tuesday, Aug. 17 at 2 p.m. in the Zwingli Church with Rev. Charles G. Workman, pastor, officiating. Interment will be in Highland Cemetery.

Friends may call tonight after 7 p.m. in the Zwingli Church memorial lounge and then Tuesday after 11 a.m. in the church sanctuary. Voegeli Funeral Service, Monroe, is handling arrangements.
