Mrs. Emil Rabe, 65, Former Resident of Monticello, Stricken

Funeral services for Mrs. Emil Rabe, 65 years of age, Brodhead, native of Mt. Pleasant township and former Monticello resident, who died Saturday afternoon in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, after an extended illness, were held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday in the Immanuel United Methodist church, Brodhead. The Rev. Paul J. Gibson, church pastor, officiated, and interment was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.

Cecile Prisk was born in Mt. Pleasant township, Dec. 12, 1902, a daughter of Ora and Ella Davis Prisk. She was united in marriage May 18, 1920, in Monroe to Emil Rabe. They resided in the village of Monticello for some years, during which Mr. Rabe was employed at the old Borden condensery here. They later farmed in the Brodhead area.

Mrs. Rabe was a member of the Immanuel United Methodist church, Brodhead and its Fellowship class, a member and secretary of the Brodhead chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star, of the Green county Barracks of World War I Auxiliary, and of the Spring Valley Faithful Farmerettes.

She is survived by her husband; two sons, Harland, Brodhead, and Merlyn, Beloit; three brothers, Raymond Prisk, Fort Atkinson, Willard and Warren, Monticello; five grandchildren, and one great-grandchild.
