John Rechsteiner, 70, Dies; Last Rites Here

Final rites for John Rechsteiner, aged 70, who passed away at 4 Friday afternoon in the Buckskin Hollow cheese factory northwest of Monroe, were conducted at 1:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Minnie Wittwer, Monticello. Rev, A. Muehlmeier, pastor of the local Reformed church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

The death of Mr. Rechsteiner came following a week's illness from pneumonia. He was a native of Switzerland, where he was born March 8, 1860. Coming to this country about fifteen years ago, Mr. Rechsteiner settled in Green county where he was usually employed in cheese factories.

Survivors are one daughter, Mrs. Wittwer, Monticello; three sons living in America; Walter, near Monticello; and John and Arnold, Bay City, Mich, and four sons residing in Switzerland.
