

Sarah Rhyner
June 3, 1870 - 1948

MONTICELLO, Wis. — Mrs. Sarah Rhyner, 78, Albany township, died Thursday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Herman Pluss, in the township.

Mrs. Rhyner was born June 3, 1870, in New Glarus, the former Sarah Freitag. She married Jacob Rhyner Oct. 21, 1886. They farmed in Pleasant township for 30 years. In 1936 she went to live with her daughter. Mr. Rhyner died in 1935.

She was a member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, Albany, its Women's guild, the Smiley Mothers' club, and the Legion auxiliary.
